SCOPE OF THE COMPETITION:

Teams will build a project using materials provided to the specifications indicated.

Instructors should be prepared to assist contestants as directed by the technical committee.

JUDGING CRITERIA: Please refer to SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards.

TOOLS AND MATERIALS REQUIRED BY CONTESTANTS:

In addition to basic carpentry tools, contestants must bring the following items:

½" router, belt sander and/or finish sander

Cordless drills and screwdrivers are encouraged. (Powered miter saws are allowed)

Sabre Saw/ Jig Saw

Reciprocating saw

Extension cords

Framing square

Compass

Chalk line

Hardhat

Safety Glasses with shields

Facemask

Leather work shoes (No Athletic Shoes allowed)

Hearing protection

SAFETY STATEMENT: All competitors must have the proper safety equipment as outlined in the *SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards and* complete the attached safety form. Safety Glasses and hearing protection are required. *Instructor(s) must remain in the competition tent during the competition.*

NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS: The first 25 SkillsUSA chapters to return the official registration form will be allowed to enter one team of two (2) contestants. Additional teams from previously registered teams will be accepted via a drawing if space allows.

^{**} All tools, equipment, and extension cords must be OSHA approved.

PROJECT PLANS: Will not be provided in advance.

ENTRY FEE: \$40.00 per team entering the competition. The registration must be accompanied by a check. Please register on-line at www.skillsusava.org, go to Event, State Fair and then to Competitions. Substitutions may be made the day of the contest. *Note: Schools dropping participants after September 16 still owe the \$40 contest fee, to cover materials. Note: Project this year property of the sponsor.*

AWARDS: Awards will be presented at the contest area.

- Participants must have a Student Competition Ticket (\$8.00) to enter the Fairgrounds unless they are already at the Fair for another competition.
- Teachers are responsible for ordering tickets online by September 27, 2022 directly from the State Fair Ticket Office using a State Fair Student Competition Ticket Order Form, which can be found on-line at www.skillsusava.org under 'State Fair'
- State fair Tickets must be ordered online so everyone may enter near contest site (Gate 2) You will be allowed to park in this area with advance tickets. No picking up tickets onsite.

MUST BE SUBMITED TO THE CHAIRMAN AT REGISTRATION OF THE CONTEST.

CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR OSHA APPROVED PPE AND CLOTHING TO

INCLUDE HARDHAT, LEATHER WORK BOOTS (does not have to be steel toed) AND SAFETY GLASSES WITH SIDE SHIELDS OR GOGGLES. CONTESTANTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE WITH TENNIS SHOES OR ATHLETIC TYPE SHOES.

A SAFETY MONITOR WILL BE OBSERVING THE CONTESTANTS DURING THE COMPETITION AND WILL STOP ANY CONTESTANT VIOLATING ANY SAFETY REGULATION. THE CONTESTANT WILL THEN ADJUST TO MEET THE REQIREMENTS OR BE DISQUALIFIED. THE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS WILL BE REVIEWED PRIOR TO THE START OF THE COMPETITION AND QUESTIONS WILL BE ANSWERED.
