Tools listed in the *SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards*.
Safety equipment listed in the *SkillsUSA Championships Technical Standards*.

NOTE: Work will be performed on an uneven surface.

Instructors will be allowed to assist team members with the first course.

NUMBER OF CONTESTANTS: The first 25 SkillsUSA chapters to return the registration form will be allowed to enter one team of two (2) contestants. Additional teams from the previously registered teams will be accepted via a drawing if space allows.

SAFETY STATEMENT: All entries must present at registration, the attached Safety Statement signed by students and advisors. Safety glasses and dress appropriate to the trade and public viewing are required.

TOOL DROP OFF:

Tools boxes maybe dropped off. Walk to will call to pick up and pay for preordered fair tickets.

- *Participants must have a Student Competition Ticket (\$8.00) to enter the Fairgrounds unless they are already at the Fair for another competition.*
- *Teachers are responsible for ordering tickets online by September 27,2022 directly from the State Fair Ticket Office using a State Fair Student Competition Ticket Order Form, which can be found on-line at www.skillsusava.org under 'State Fair'*
- *State Fair tickets must be ordered online so everyone may enter near the contest site (gate 2) You will be allowed to park in this area with advance tickets. No picking up tickets on site.*

Safety Notice: Each contestant is responsible for bringing the proper PPE to wear while participation in the contest. Also, each contestant must turn in a signed SkillsUSA Safety Form to the competition chairman on the day of the competition.
