The scope of the contest will be drawn from these standards. **NOTE: ALL contest are subject to increased difficulty levels from previous state competitions in order to align the scope and skill level to that of National Competitions.**

Friday, April 19, 2024– 4 p.m. – “Action Plan” Presentations held at the Virginia Beach Convention Center, Contest Area

**“ALL TEAM MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE PROOF OF OSHA 10 CERTIFICATION PRIOR TO COMPETITION”**

The contest is not considered over until the area has been cleaned. Tear-down and removal is worth up to fifty (50) points.

Contestants should report a few minutes early to the contest site with their name tag turned so that their contestant number is showing.

Contestants must wear professional dress keeping with the SkillsUSA image and within recognized safety dress standards for the construction trade. No loose clothing or shirttails out or sleeves unbuttoned. You will be graded on how your work clothes look for the job at hand.

Contestants must provide and wear leather work shoes or boots and OSHA approved safety glasses with side shields or goggles and a hardhat.

**Contestants must submit resume to the contest chair prior to the beginning of the contest:**

- **Resumes, one page;** resume is worth 10% of the total contest score.
- **OSHA card, certificate or letter** verifying OSHA training.



## TeamWorks Competition 2024 (continued)

Presentation: Friday, April 19, 2024 at 4 p.m. until 5:30 p.m. - Teams will have 15 minutes to develop an "Action Plan" based on the drawing prepared by contest officials. Teams may leave once their presentation is completed. The three to five minute presentation must be in accordance with the guidelines in the *2018-2019 Skills Championships Technical Standards*.

Tools: Contestants must bring all tools listed in the current technical standards except for the items noted below. In addition, teams may bring a ½" power drill w/ 2 ½" and 4" hole saw and ¾" wood bit. Contestants may bring bar clamps, hand held power skill saw, 4' or 6' step ladder, sawzall, and a right angle drill. Contestants may not bring chop saws. **\*\*Please note: no power nailers will be allowed.**

**Contestants do NOT need to bring the following items:**

- **Two saw horses** (students may bring their own, if they wish)
- **Cutters suitable for cast-iron soil pipe**
- **Torque wrench for no-hub clamps**

**CONTESTANTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO CARRY/USE CELL PHONES. NO CELL PHONES WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE CONTEST AREA.**

**SAFETY IS OF THE UPMOST IMPORTANCE.**

Contestants shall have a thorough knowledge of operational and safety procedures for all tools (especially the skillsaw and the properly adjusted cut depth) and equipment listed in the scope of the contest.

All accidents, no matter how slight, are to be reported to a contest official.
